SUBJECT: RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING STATE SHARED REVENUES
DATE: June 22, 2016

Background

ORS 221.770, pertaining to state-shared revenues, requires cities to adopt an ordinance or resolution stating that they want to receive state revenue sharing money. It further requires cities to pass a resolution stating that the city provides at least four designated municipal services. Provisions of the law require cities to certify that two public hearings were held: one before the Budget Committee and one before the City Council giving citizens an opportunity to comment on uses of State Revenue Sharing funds.


The resolutions concerning state shared revenues are required every year if the City intends to receive these revenues in the following fiscal year.


Recommendation

It is staff's recommendation that the Council adopt one Resolution declaring the City's election to receive state revenues and adopt another Resolution relating to City's eligibility to receive state-shared revenues. These are two separate resolutions that are required.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY OF COTTAGE GROVE'S ELECTION
TO RECEIVE STATE REVENUES

WHEREAS, ORS 221.770 requires the City of Cottage Grove to elect to receive state shared revenues for fiscal year 2016-2017 if the City is to receive them; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that they want to receive state shared revenues for fiscal year 2016-2017;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to ORS 221.770, the City of Cottage Grove hereby elects to receive state shared revenues for fiscal year 2016-2017.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effective immediately upon its passage.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE CITY OF COTTAGE GROVE'S ELIGIBILITY TO RECEIVE STATE SHARED REVENUES (CIGARETTE, LIQUOR, AND HIGHWAY TAXES) UNDER ORS 221.760

WHEREAS, ORS 221.760 provides as follows:

The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820 and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:

- (1) Police protection
- (2) Fire protection
- (3) Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
- (4) Sanitary sewer
- (5) Storm sewers
- (6) Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- (7) One or more utility services; and

WHEREAS, city officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state officer responsible for determining the eligibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Cottage Grove hereby certifies that it provides the following four or more municipal services enumerated in Section 1, ORS 221.760:

- (1) Police protection
- (2) Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
- (3) Sanitary sewer
- (4) Storm sewers
- (5) Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- (6) Water services

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
